THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE - The Beauty and the Power

A TV quality exploration of how the Sacrament of Marriage can help a couple to love in the power of the Holy Spirit.

The teaching of the Church is supported by three moving documentaries of couples at different stages of married life, ranging from the excitement of the wedding, through the hectic years of family life and finally to the joy of marriage in older age.

Ideal for marriage preparation, enrichment, RCIA, teenagers in schools & Confirmation courses.

The main session lasts approx 25 minutes and is supported by a short general introduction to the Sacraments by Fr Paul Keane and Sr Catherine Droste OP

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - The Call to Serve

A TV quality exploration of the power of the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

The teaching of the Church is supported by three moving documentaries of a Seminarian receiving ordination, a Permanent Deacon serving the poor and a day in the life of a Parish Priest.

Ideal for RCIA, Vocations, teenagers in schools & Confirmation courses.

The main session lasts approx 25 minutes and is supported by a short general introduction to the Sacraments by Fr Paul Keane and Sr Catherine Droste

THE SACRAMENTS - transforming everyday life

A TV quality exploration of the Sacraments of Initiation.

A four-session DVD course exploring:

- **Why Sacraments?**
- **Baptism**
- **Confirmation**
- **The Eucharist**

Ideal for parish courses, RCIA, prayer groups and schools.

The sessions range between 19 and 27 minutes.

BAPTISM - helping your child get the most from life

This flexible short course is designed to inform, inspire and stir discussion amongst parents.

Each session lasts approximately 45 minutes (including short times of sharing) and can be, if necessary, incorporated into a single session.

The course includes input from David Payne (Director of CaFE), Archbishop Vincent Nichols and numerous parents and children.
